Report:

The programme commenced with a prayer song by the college choir. **Mrs. Thagira Banu, Head and Assistant Professor of Chemistry**, delivered the welcome address and extended a warm welcome to the gathering. The **Chief Guest and Resource Person, Rev. Fr. Dr. Arnald Mahesh I, SDB, Rector & Director, Don Bosco Anbu Illam, Ukkadam, Coimbatore**, was introduced by **Mrs. N. Nishadeenu, Assistant Professor of English**. The programme was presided over by **Dr. S. Gayathri, Principal**, who delivered the Presidential Address. She emphasized the importance of commitment and dedication in the teaching profession. She highlighted that meaningful teaching goes beyond syllabus completion and focuses on shaping students' knowledge, values, and character. She encouraged the faculty members to rediscover the true purpose of education and become inspiring mentors who create a positive impact on students' lives.

The resource person delivered an inspiring and thought-provoking session on the role of educators in transforming teaching-learning practices. He encouraged the faculty members to move beyond syllabus completion and focus on creating meaningful, value-based, and impactful learning experiences. During the session, he emphasized that **every individual has a story to share, but not everyone gets the opportunity to express it**. He highlighted the importance of understanding students' backgrounds, experiences, and aspirations. He also shared valuable insights about **John Elster's ideas** and discussed the significance of preserving and understanding our **traditions and values** in the modern educational scenario. He also appreciated the efforts of the children and encouraged everyone to watch inspiring films and learn from the messages conveyed through them. He motivated the faculty members to become compassionate educators who guide students not only academically but also personally and socially.

During the session, he shared various motivational stories and real-life examples. He explained about **Mahatma Gandhi's simple lifestyle and unique thoughts**, emphasizing that true greatness comes from simplicity, values, and dedication. He motivated the faculty members to develop a different perspective and follow noble principles in their personal and professional life. He narrated several inspiring stories including the story of a **hardworking fisherman, Muhammad Ali**, and **Abu Bakar** to highlight perseverance, confidence, and commitment. He also shared the story of the **Thailand Buddha becoming the Golden Buddha**, explaining that every person has hidden talents and potential that need to be recognized. The resource person conducted an interactive discussion on the **camel**, asking thought-provoking questions such as:

1. Why does a camel have a hump?
2. Why does a camel have longer legs?
3. Why does a camel have long eyelashes?

Through these questions, he encouraged the faculty members to observe nature, think critically, and understand the purpose behind every creation. He also discussed differences in male and female dressing styles and connected them with social understanding and human behaviour. He shared a meaningful discussion between a mother and child and encouraged the participants to understand the emotions and experiences of students. He also narrated a motivational story about a **barber and a young man**, highlighting the importance of the title and message of every story. The resource person also narrated the story of **Lord Shiva and Narayana**, where Narayana was given a task to bring water. Through the story, he explained the importance of concentration, responsibility, and how situations can change when our focus is diverted. The session was highly informative, interactive, and enriched the faculty members with new ideas, innovative teaching approaches, and deeper reflections on the role of an educator. The resource person further discussed various important aspects of effective teaching and the responsibilities of educators. He explained the

Significance of understanding the **physical structure and environmental adaptations of living beings**, including temperature management and survival techniques, which help students develop observation and analytical skills.

He emphasized the importance of **caring for students and understanding their individual abilities**. He advised the faculty members not to underestimate any student or compare one student with another, as every learner has unique potential. He highlighted the need for maintaining personal contact with students and treating all students equally. He also stressed that calling students by their names creates a sense of belonging and happiness. He explained that a teacher should have a pleasant appearance, a simple personality, and a smiling face to create a positive learning environment. The resource person encouraged teachers to provide opportunities for students to express their creativity and develop critical thinking skills. He explained that true love means wishing for the good and growth of others. He highlighted the importance of **problem-solving skills**, acknowledging students' problems, and providing proper guidance. He also spoke about promoting **emotional intelligence and the well-being of students** to create a healthy and supportive classroom environment. He emphasized that teachers have the responsibility of preparing **global citizens** by giving importance to **social and emotional learning**. He encouraged faculty members to implement cultural responsibilities, digital literacy, and equity in the classroom. He concluded the session by stating that **"Motivation is the fuel necessary to keep the human engine running"**, inspiring teachers to continuously motivate themselves and their students towards excellence.

The programme concluded with the **vote of thanks proposed by Mrs. Manogari, Head and Assistant Professor of Mathematics**. She expressed her sincere gratitude to the management, principal, resource person, IQAC team, and all the faculty members for their support and cooperation.

The Faculty Development Programme was successfully completed with active participation from the faculty members.
