Report:

The Parent Teacher Meeting was organized on **17th June 2026** at the **New Auditorium of Bon Secours Arts & Science College for Women, Dindigul**. The programme began with a **prayer song rendered by the College Choir**, followed by the **lighting of the lamp**. The auspicious lamp was lit by the **Secretary, Rev. Sr. Dr. Nesa Soundaram, the Principal, Dr. S. Gayathiri, and the first two students who got admission for the Academic Year 2026–2027 along with their parents**, symbolizing the beginning of a new academic journey filled with knowledge, hope, and success. Mrs. A. Julie delivered the welcome address and highlighted the importance of collaboration between parents and teachers in shaping the future of students.
