Report on a Two-Day Acting Workshop - 15.07.2026 & 16.07.2026

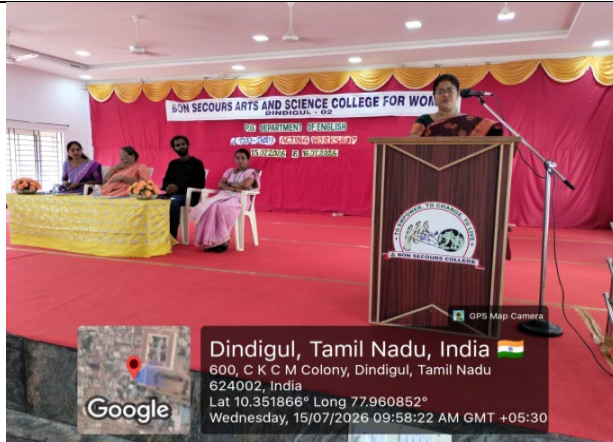
Objectives

- To improve creativity, imagination, and emotional expression through acting activities.
- To promote teamwork, leadership, and collaborative learning among students.
- To provide hands-on experience in voice modulation, body language, facial expressions, and character portrayal.

The PG Department of English, in association with the Emerald Association, organized a Two-Day Acting Workshop on 15th and 16th July 2026 from 9.30 a.m. to 2.15 p.m. at the New Auditorium of Bon Secours Arts and Science College for Women, Dindigul. The inaugural programme commenced with a Prayer Song, followed by the Welcome Address delivered by Mrs. Sathiya, Assistant Professor, Department of English. 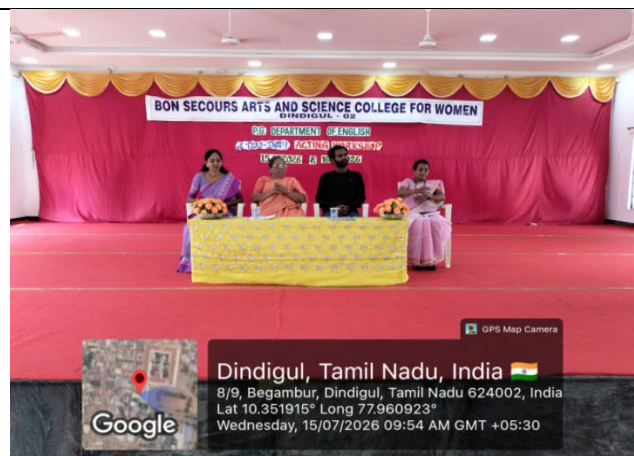
A Two-Day Acting Workshop (Inaugural ceremony) - 15.07.2026

Through a variety of interactive activities, warm-up exercises, and improvisation techniques, he encouraged the students to overcome stage fear, express themselves confidently, and develop effective communication skills. Students from the Department of English, along with participants from various other departments, actively participated in the sessions with great enthusiasm, making the first day both lively and enriching.
