REPORT ON FIVE-DAY INTERNATIONAL LEVEL FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM


The PG Department of English, Bon Secours Arts and Science College for Women, Dindigul, conducted a Five-Day International Level Faculty Development Program (Virtual Mode) on "Digital Literature and Virtual Realities: Future Directions in Literary Research" from 18th to 22nd August 2025, between 5.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. The program featured eminent scholars who shared their expertise on literature, digital media, artificial intelligence, and sustainability. The sessions were hosted via Google Meet, with an active participation of faculty members and research scholars from various institutions.

The objective of the Five-Day International Level Faculty Development Program, was to enlighten the audience on the growing significance of Artificial Intelligence and its careful applications in literary analysis and research.

Day 1 (18.08.2025)

The inaugural session began with a warm welcome address by Ms. M. Vennila, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of English. This was followed by the Presidential Address delivered by Rev. Sr. Dr. Sirumalar, Principal of the College. The technical session was led by **Dr. T.S. 


Thanks was given by Ms B. Wanisha Sameera, Assistant Professor. The session was attended by 82 participants.
